WELCOME TO THE FANTATIC SPORT OF INLINE HOCKEY

Inline hockey was first played in NZ from 1993

I went to the first official tournament in Coolangatta—Australia in 1994

This was the first tournament any person from NZ attended and I came back knowing that this sport was fast and a great spectator sport.

The Hamilton Inline Hockey Club was formed in 1995 and Incorporated in 1996.

We are the biggest club in NZ due to commitment and hard work over the years by past and present committee members/players to ensure that the sport has continued to grow.

Granted the cost of the sport can be more expensive than some other sports but as an indoor sport we have not got

the advantage of having council grounds to play on.

As with everything in life there are pro's and con's and with a positive attitude the sport will continue to grow.

What other sport runs from Feb—Dec does not have to worry about supporters and players in adverse weather conditions and forms friendships all over NZ forming personal relationships.

FRIDAY NIGHT SKATE

This session runs from 7pm—9.30pm.

Every Friday night (public holidays excluded)

You as members/parents are required to help on a rostered basis.

The rosters are by team. With 16 teams you are therefore only required once every four months.

This is one of our big income earners (\$31.000 last year) and we must have your support. You are needed at the rink by 6.45pm at the latest and leave after all jobs have

been completed which is usually no later than 10pm.

At present we are averaging 150 customers which at \$6 pp entry that is \$900 clear profit plus we have the profits from skate hire and tuck shop sales.

Your help is therefore invaluable and your support is required to pay our bills.

For those that are new we pay a rental of **\$87.300** annually plus power, insurance etc.
